NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the authority vested in them by SDCL 1-26, the South Dakota Transportation Commission will hold a public hearing in the Commission Room of the Becker Hansen Building at 700 East Broadway Avenue in Pierre, South Dakota on **October 23, 2014**, at 9:05 am (CST) to consider the proposed amendment to the following rule:

**70:01:02:67(2)** – An existing 35 mph limited speed zone on U.S. Highway 83 in Todd County beginning 0.3 mile south of the intersection of U.S. Highway 18 is being extended an additional 0.25 mile south to reduce traffic speed past the new elementary school entrance and improve safety. The extended speed zone area will also aid in the future design of turn lanes in this location.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rule may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Transportation, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2586. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Transportation by **October 22, 2014**, to be considered.

After the hearing, the commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
