Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the Anderson Building, Room 109, 445 E. Capitol Ave., Pierre, South Dakota, on December 1, 2014 at 9:00 a.m., to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules to the following:

Property and Special Taxes

64:02:03:02

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to clarify the requirements for the renewal of certified appraiser assessor certificates.

The effect of the rule change will update the current applicable renewal requirements in this chapter.

64:02:03:16, 64:02:03:16.01, 64:02:03:16.02, 64:02:03:16.03

The reason for adopting the proposed rule changes is to revise the requirements for maintaining the professional designation of a “Certified Appraiser Assessor.”

The effect of the rule changes will update the course requirements that must be met within each five year renewal period.

64:02:03:19

The reason for adopting the proposed rule change is to update the requirements for testing and retesting courses at annual assessor schools.

The effect of the rule change will allow the department to waive the testing requirement for certain courses.

64:03:01:02.01, 64:04:01:20

The reason for adopting the proposed rule changes is to update manuals and price of manuals to the current version that must be used by assessors in calculating the value of non-residential and residential property.

The effect of the rule changes will update manuals and price of manuals to current version and ensure that the language of the rules is consistent.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Revenue – Legal Division, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-3185. Material sent by mail must reach the Department by December 11, 2014, to be considered.

After the hearing, the Department of Revenue will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
