Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in City Hall, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, on Thursday, September 24, 2015, at 9:00 o'clock a.m., MDT, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered:

GAMING RULES: 20:18:01:01, 20:18:15:01.01, 20:18:16:02,
20:18:16:15.14, 20:18:16:15.19, 20:18:16:15.20

GAMING RULES:

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:01:01. Definitions. The effect of the amendment is to add a definition for House Banked Table Games.

The reason for the change is to clarify games in which a player wagers against the licensee.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:15:01.01. Types of blackjack authorized. The effect of the amendment is to add new versions of blackjack to the list of authorized blackjack games.

The reason for the amendment is to update the authorized games of blackjack recognizing additional games adopted by the Commission.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:02. Types of poker authorized. The effect of the rule amendment is to include within the authorized games of poker new games adopted by the Commission.

The reason for the rule amendment is to recognize the Commission's adoption of new games of poker.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:15.14. The play – Mississippi Stud with optional three card bonus. The effect of the rule amendment is to authorize a variation of Mississippi Stud poker.

The reason for the change is to recognize a request by the originator of the game, Shufflemaster, Inc.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:16:15.19. The play -- Flushes Gone Wild. The effect of the new rule is to create a new variation of poker known as Flushes Gone Wild.

The reason for the new rule is to recognize a request by the game's originator, Shufflemaster, Inc.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:16:15.20. The play – Hot Poker Spot. The effect of the new rule is to create a new variation of poker known as Hot Poker Spot.

The reason for the new rule is to recognize a request by the game's originator, Gaming Partners International USA, Inc.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rule changes may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Commission on Gaming, 221 West Capitol Avenue, Suite 101, c/o 1320 East Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, 57501-3100. Materials sent by mail must reach the Commission on Gaming by Wednesday, September 23, 2015, to be considered. However, the Commission requests that all written comments be received by Monday, September 21, 2015, to allow for adequate consideration prior to the hearing.

After the hearing, the Commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule changes. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to any individual with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
