Notice of Public Hearing to Revise and Repeal Rules

A public hearing will be held in the first floor conference room of the Sutherland Building, 118 West Capitol Avenue in Pierre, South Dakota, on Tuesday, August 2nd, 2016 at 10:00am central time to consider the proposed revision of the administrative rules numbered:

20:01:02:01, 20:01:02:02, 20:01:02:03, 20:01:06:02 through 20:01:06:09 inclusive, 20:01:07:02, 20:01:07:04, 20:01:07:05, 20:01:07:07, 20:01:07:09, 20:01:08:06, 20:01:09:02, 20:15:06:01, 61:15:01:01 through 61:15:01:06 inclusive, 61:15:01:08, 61:15:01:09, 61:15:01:13, 61:15:01:16 through 61:15:01:19 inclusive, 61:15:02:03 through 61:15:02:08 inclusive, 61:15:05:05 through 61:15:05:08 inclusive, 61:15:06:01, 61:15:06:05, through 61:15:06:08 inclusive, 61:15:07:01, 61:15:07:03, 61:15:07:09, 61:15:07:14, 61:15:07:15, 61:15:07:16, 61:15:07:19, 61:15:07:21 through 61:15:07:24 inclusive, 61:15:07:28, 61:15:07:29, and 61:15:07:30; and the proposed repeal of rules §§ 20:01:10:03 through 20:01:10:06 inclusive.

The effect of the rules will be to update the adoptions of the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) and the International Building, Fire, and Mechanical Codes, to update and revise references, to require the use of certified test weights, to allow NIST traceable field test standards for refined fuels and liquid petroleum gas, and to repeal repetitive rules.

The reasons for adopting the proposed rules are to allow the utilization of modern weights and measures technology and test methods; to utilize current, safe building practices; and to update and clarify the listed rules.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Public Safety, 118 West Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Standards by August 16, 2016 to be considered.

After the hearing, the Department will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
