

South Dakota State Board of Dentistry
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at the SD Housing Development Authority Board Room 3060 E. Elizabeth St. Pierre, South Dakota, 57501, on October 20, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered: § 20:43:06:01; 20:43:06:02; 20:43:06:03; 20:43:06:04; 20:43:06:05. A previous hearing on these rules was held June 16, 2017. Due to an error of the Capital Journal and its failure to publish the original notice, the Board of Dentistry is holding another public hearing.

The effect of the rules will be to update the registration process for dental entities to bring it into compliance with SB 47 and repeal obsolete provisions.

The reasons for adopting these rules are to remove obsolete provisions and references, provide grammatical clarity, and update administrative rules to comply with SB 47.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota State Board of Dentistry, PO Box 1079, Pierre, South Dakota, 57501. Written comments must reach the Board of Dentistry office on or before October 17, 2017 to be considered. Any written comments previously submitted will be considered.

At the hearing, the Board of Dentistry will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules, including those previously submitted. The Board of Dentistry may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Please notify the Board of Dentistry at least 48 hours before the public hearing if you have special needs for which special arrangements must be made.
