Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in City Hall, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, on Wednesday, September 6, 2017, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered:

RACING RULES: 20:04:20:17, 20:04:20:103, 20:04:24:124, 20:04:33:03

GAMING RULES: 20:18:15:30.17, 20:18:16:11, 20:18:16:15.22, 20:18:33:12.01

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:04:20:17. Officials of the Race. The effect of the amendment is to add outriders to the officials for a race meeting.

The reason for the amendment is to bring the rule into conformance with current practices at race tracks utilizing outriders as officials.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:04:20:103. Duties of the Outriders. The effect of this new rule is to set forth the duties of outrider officials.

The reason for the new rule is to explain the duties of the outriders with the addition of outriders as officials.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:04:24:124. Workouts required for eligibility. The effect of the amendment is to clarify workouts necessary for eligibility of a horse.

The reason for the amendment is that compliance with the existing rule is increasingly difficult with the limited availability of horses and qualified riders.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:04:33:03. Deposit of money. The effect of the rule amendment is to eliminate the requirement that deposits of money for multi-jurisdictional totalizator hubs be located in banks in South Dakota.

The reason for the amendment is to recognize changes in banking technology and consolation of banks within the banking industry.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:15:30.17. Variations of the play – TriLux Bonus Blackjack with Super 3. The effect of the new rule is to adopt a new variation of the game of blackjack called TriLux Bonus Blackjack with Super 3.

The reason for the new rule is to consider a request for a new variation of blackjack from Bally Gaming, Inc.

Proposed rule amendment: ARSD 20:18:16:11. The play – Texas Hold'em. The effect of the rule amendment is to allow an option to play the game of Texas Hold'em twice.

The reason for the amendment is to consider a request for the option to play the game twice by Cadillac Jack's Gaming Casino.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:16:15.22. The play – Cover All Bonus. The effect of the new rule is to adopt a new variation of the game of poker called Cover All Bonus.

The reason for the new rule is to consider a request for a new variation of poker from Bally Gaming, Inc.

Proposed new rule: ARSD 20:18:33:12.01. Variation of the play – Sharp Shooter. The effect of the new rule is to adopt a new variation of the game of craps called Sharp Shooter.

The reason for the new rule is to consider a request for a new variation of craps from Bally Gaming, Inc.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rule changes may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Commission on Gaming, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, 57501, or by e-mail to larry.eliason@state.sd.us. Materials sent by mail must reach the Commission on Gaming by Monday, September 4, 2017, to be considered. However, the Commission requests that all written comments be received by Friday, September 1, 2017, to allow for adequate consideration prior to the hearing.

After the hearing, the Commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rule changes. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to any individual with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
