Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at Mitchell Technical Institute, Technology Center, Amphitheater, 1800 E Spruce Street, Mitchell, South Dakota, on December 15, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules:

transfer §§ 24:10:42 to 24:10:43, inclusive,
24:10:45 to 24:10:46, inclusive,
24:10:49 to a new location: §§ 24:59,
and amendments to §§ 24:10:48, 46:30:06:09 and 50:06:01:01

The effect and purpose of the proposed rules is to transfer existing rules from Article 24:10 under the Board of Education Standards to Article 24:59 under the Board of Technical Education to comply with 2017 legislation. The proposed rules also amend relevant references from the director of Career and Technical Education to the Executive Director of the Board of Technical Education, references from the Board of Education Standards to the Board of Technical Education, and references from the Department of Education to the Board of Technical Education.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Education, Attn: Board of Technical Education, 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, 57501, or transmitting the information to nick.wendell@state.sd.us. Material sent by mail or email must reach the Department on or before December 11, 2017, to be considered.

At the hearing, the board will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
