Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at the George S. Mickelson Criminal Justice Center, Commission Conference Room, 1302 East Highway 14, Pierre, South Dakota, on February 23, 2018, at 10:00 a.m., to consider the amendment of rule number 2:06:03:03.

The effect of the proposed amended rule will be to increase the fee that a participant shall pay for each drug patch while participating in the 24/7 Sobriety Program.

The reason for amending the rule is to account for the increased amount charged by the drug patch provider so that the 24/7 Sobriety Program testing sites can continue to offer drug patch testing to participants without a financial loss to the testing sites.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed amended rule may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the Office of the Attorney General, 1302 East Highway 14, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the Office of Attorney General by March 5, 2018, to be considered.

After the hearing, the Attorney General's Office will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed amended rule. The Attorney General may modify the proposed amended rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
