On October 19, 2018, at 11:00AM MDT/12:00PM CDT, to consider the amendment of the following Board of Podiatry Examiners rules:

The effect of the rules will be to update language relating to continuing education requirements, removes language regarding examinations by the Board, updates the language for qualifications of license applicants including a clear definition of current educational requirements and the required national standardized examinations, updates language for applicants holding an out of state license, replaces verbiage of certificate of registration with license, removes antiquated language relating to officers of the Board, updates to the most recent version of the Code of Ethics of the American Podiatric Medical Association.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Board of Podiatry Examiners, 810 N. Material sent by mail or email must reach the Board at least 72 hours before the public hearing, to be considered.

After the hearing, the board will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
