NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the authority vested in the South Dakota Transportation Commission by South Dakota Codified Law chapter 1-26, the commission will hold a public hearing in the Commission Room of the Becker Hansen Building at 700 East Broadway Avenue in Pierre, South Dakota, on Thursday, **January 31, 2019**, at 9:00 a.m. (Central Time) to consider proposed changes to the following rules:

70:01:02:12 – Bon Homme County speed zone. The 55 miles per hour (mph) speed zone on State Trunk Highway 50 in and around Tyndall is being extended in a westerly direction. The purpose of the proposed rule change is to enhance safety.

Article 70:14 – Highway Project Loans for Local Governments. The Department is adopting administrative rules to establish procedures for the application and approval of loans to local government highway jurisdictions for the marking, constructing, reconstructing, repairing, and maintenance of highways and bridges of the state. The purpose of the proposed rules is to provide a clear process for assisting local governments with the financing of public highway and bridge improvements.

At the hearing, interested persons will be given reasonable opportunity to submit amendments, data, opinions, and arguments, either orally or in writing, or both. Interested persons may mail amendments, data, opinions, and arguments to the South Dakota Department of Transportation, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2586 or transmit the information by e-mail to Darin.Bergquist@state.sd.us. Information submitted by mail or e-mail must reach the Department of Transportation on or before **Monday, January 28, 2019**, to be considered.

After the hearing, the commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
