Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at Lake Area Technical Institute, Student Center, 1201 Arrow Ave NE, Watertown, South Dakota, on May 15, 2019, 9:00 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules:

Chapter 24:59:02 (Postsecondary Technical Institute Funding Distribution).

The effect and purpose of the proposed changes to Chapter 24:59:02 are to update the yearly facility fund and National Guard tuition benefit fund set-asides from the total state appropriation, and to update the yearly per student allocation appropriated by the SD Legislature in the postsecondary technical institute funding formula.
