Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the Appraiser Certification Program Conference Room, 308 South Pierre Street, Pierre, South Dakota, on June 18, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rule numbered

§§ 20:14:02:02; 20:14:03:01(9) and (10); 20:14:04:15(9); 20:14:05:01.01(4);
20:14:12:02(4); and 20:77:03:01(4) and (6), inclusive

The effect of the rules will be to require applicants for an initial appraiser credential, a renewing credentialed appraiser, a supervisory appraiser; and an appraisal management company registration to provide the Department an email address and eliminate the requirement for a notarized affidavit or irrevocable Uniform Consent to Service of Process form.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is for the Department to implement a fully online application process, with built in security measures for signature authentication, which requires the Department to have an email address for all applicants and will eliminate the need to have affidavits or Uniform Consent to Service of Process forms notarized before a Notary Public.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Labor and Regulation, Appraiser Certification Program, 308 South Pierre Street, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-3137. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Labor and Regulation by June 28, 2019, to be considered.

After the hearing, the Department will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
