Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the Conference Room on the 1st floor of the Sutherland Building, 118 West Capitol Ave, Pierre, South Dakota, on August 12, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., to consider the amendment of proposed rules numbered:

ARSD 20:15:06:01, 61:23:01:04, 67:55:04:01 and 67:55:04:03

The effect of the rules will be to expand the 1 psi Reid Vapor Pressure waiver, adopt the 2019 edition of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance handbook, expand the definition of immediate family for crime victims' compensation and to expand the service period for which victims of crime may be reimbursed for counseling services.

The reason for revising the proposed rules is to facilitate fuel availability and usage, utilize the most current version of the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance handbook, to allow payment of some additional compensation to family members of crime victims and to allow crime victims reimbursement for counselling immediately after victimization.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Public Safety, 118 West Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Public Safety by August 26, 2019, to be considered.

After the hearing, the Department will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Please notify the Department of Public Safety at least 48 hours before the public hearing if you have special needs for which special arrangements must be made.
