

**South Dakota Board of Examiners in Optometry
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules**

A public hearing will be held at Tieszen Law Office, Prof. LLC, 306 East Capitol, Suite 300, Pierre, South Dakota 57501, on March 6, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. (CST), to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered:

The effect of the rules will be to clarify existing language for release of prescriptions, establish and clarify process for license renewal and late renewal fee, update and clean up continuing education requirements and documentation, revise requirements of notification of change in professional corporation membership; and add one CPT code to clinical procedures approved for optometrist.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is provide clarify, to address a current lack of process for reinstatement of licensure after default or absence, to make continuing education requirements more clear, to update corporate requirements, and to add a procedure to those approved for optometrists.

The South Dakota Board of Examiners in Optometry may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
