The effect of the rules will be to amend the general application requirements regarding the applicants condition related to their ability to practice.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is: the existing language only addresses substance abuse and mental health conditions. Revising the language creates a more inclusive approach by including any current impairment that may impact the ability to practice.

The Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
