

South Dakota State Library Board
Amended Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in the MacKay Building, First Floor, Library Commons, 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on May 7, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered

Section 24:30:02:06

(Replacement charges for library materials and equipment lost or damaged by users).

The reason of the proposed changes to Section 24:30:02:06 is to update fees charged to library users who damage or lose state library materials.

The effect of the proposed changes is that fees will be more reflective of today's charges to replace library books or other formats that are no longer in print. Libraries also have new equipment, like virtual reality headsets, 3D printers in makerspace areas, hotspots available for borrowing, educational kits with many parts, for example, that libraries can check out for community programs.
