## Department of Social Services Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at the DSS Building, Pheasant Conference Room, 811 East 10th Street, Sioux Falls, SD 57103 on Friday, July 9, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed Behavioral Health rules numbered

§§ 67:61:01:01, 67:61:12:03, 67:61:13:04, 67:61:14:04, 67:61:16:05, 67:62:01:01, 67:62:10:03, 67:62:11:03, 67:62:12:03, and 67:62:13:07.

The effect of the rule changes will be to add a definition for telehealth, to update rules to continue telemedicine and audio-only flexibilities beyond the pandemic, and to update billable units.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to continue telemedicine and audio-only flexibilities as a reimbursable service beyond the pandemic. The billable unit has also been updated to reflect more flexibilities.
