Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at 101 N. Main Ave., in the First Dakota National Bank building in room 306, Sioux Falls, South Dakota on June 8, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. (CT)/8:00 a.m. (MT) to consider the adoption of proposed rules numbered: §§20:61:02:01, 20:61:02:02, 20:61:02:03, 20:63:01:01. The effect of §20:61:02:01, 20:61:02:02, 20:61:02:03 is to create educational requirements and training for the issuance of a critical care endorsement. The reason for adopting §20:61:02:01, 20:61:02:02, 20:61:02:03 is to provide an additional pathway for eligible personnel to receive the critical care endorsement. The effect of 20:63:01:01 is to update the educational standards of Athletic Trainers to the 2020 Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education, which is currently recognized nationally. The reason for the update is the current rule cites the 5th Edition National Athletic Trainers Association Education Competencies, which is now outdated.
