**IMPACT ON GOVERNMENT SUMMARY:** These rules will have no impact on processes, schedules, or activities of any state or local government.

**FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:** Pursuant to SDCL 1-26-4.2, these rules will have \$54,925 positive fiscal impact to Board of Pharmacy. No additional Board of Pharmacy staff or resources will be required to implement rules. Most rules are verbiage clean up only.

**FISCAL IMPACT BASIS:** Section 04 Pharmacist fees increase by \$25 per year as allowed by SDCL 36-11- 23 (statutory cap) will provide an additional \$54,925 in fee revenue to the Board. There are approximately 2197 pharmacists at \$25 increase for \$54,925. This number may decrease or increase. The Board voted not to pay the SD Pharmacist Association the 80% this year at the December Board meeting so this amount will remain with the Board.
