

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
DEPARTMENT OF GAME, FISH AND PARKS**

A Public Hearing will be held at the NFAA Easton Yankton Archery Center, 800 Archery Ln, Yankton, SD 57078 at 2:00 pm (Central Time) on Thursday, July 10, 2025, to consider adoption, amendment and repeal of Administrative Rules of South Dakota numbered

1. ARSD 41:03:07 – Pete Lien & Sons Shooting Sports Complex Fees.

Effect: This proposal would establish day pass, annual pass, and event fees for the Pete Lien & Sons Shooting Sports Complex.

Reason: To help offset maintenance and operation costs at the Pete Lien & Sons Shooting Sports Complex.

2. ARSD 41:06:25:01 – Custer State Park antelope hunting season established –
Number and type of license.

Effect: This proposal would provide a hunting season, and provide a number of licenses for Custer State Park antelope.

Reason: Based on annual ground survey data, the Custer State Park antelope population can provide some antelope hunting opportunity.

3. ARSD 41:06:25:02 – Number of licenses – Type -- Dates.

Effect: Provide for the repeal of this section.

Reason: This is no longer needed since the number, type, and dates of licenses will be described in ARSD 41:06:25:01.

4. ARSD 41:06:07:02 – Eligibility of past licensees.

Effect: Modify to specify that a person who receives an antelope license in Custer State Park may not apply for that season for 9 years.

Reason: The current rule is specific to “any antelope” license types, and the Department is recommending “buck antelope” license types for 2025.

Persons interested in presenting amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may appear in-person at the hearing, or mail or e-mail them to the office of the Secretary of the Department of Game, Fish, and Parks, Foss Building, 523 East Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota 57501, or by going to the GFP website at <http://gfp.sd.gov/forms/positions>. The deadline to submit any such written comments is 72 hours prior to the date of the hearing. All written and email comments must include the name, hometown/city, and state of the person submitting the comments.

After the written comment period, the Commission will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Commission may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
