

South Dakota Board of Accountancy
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held via Microsoft Teams, on April 30, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed Administrative Rules of South Dakota numbered:

§§ 20:75:02:04, 20:75:03:04, 20:75:03:12, and 20:75:03:15.

The effect of the rules will be clarifying the definition for education, experience and issuing a license to an applicant licensed by another state.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to create a new pathway to sit for the CPA exam and to obtain CPA licensure.

Persons interested in presenting amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may appear via Microsoft Teams at the hearing, or mail or e-mail them to South Dakota Board of Accountancy, 1501 S Highline Ave, Suite 4A Sioux Falls, SD 57110 or email at accountancy@state.sd.us. The deadline to submit any such written comments for consideration is seventy-two hours before the date of the public hearing and no later than 10:00 a.m. Central Time on April 27, 2026.

After the written comment period, the Board of Accountancy will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Board of Accountancy may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
