The effect of the rules will be to: set the education, work experience, supervision, and examination requirement for peer support services; update the education, work experience, supervision and examination requirements for addiction counseling and prevention services; establish the requirements of board approved supervision to meet the requirements for the board to certify or license providers of peer support, addiction counseling and prevention services; set the standards for renewal of a recognition, certification or license issued by the Board; and clarify the standards for providing services through electronic means.

The reason for the proposed rules is to fully implement House Bill 1029 which established the Board's jurisdiction for the certification of peer support specialists and establishes the role and responsibilities of a board approved supervisor to ensure completion of the required work experience for certification or licensure. The proposed rules provide a comprehensive update through a repeal and replace of the current administrative rules for certification and licensure of addiction counseling and prevention services. The update reorganizes the education, work experience, supervision, and examination requirements for each category of services certified or licensed by the Board for consistency among the services. The proposed rules also set the standards for ethical practice, reciprocity and certification or licensure by endorsement, and standards for services provided through electronic means.

After the written comment period, the Board of Addiction and Prevention Professionals shall consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Board of Addiction and Prevention Professionals may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
