This rule amendment will increase the ownership inspection fee \$0.45 per head, changing the fee from \$1.00 per head to \$1.45 per head. The \$1.45 per head fee will generate additional revenue needed to continue operating the Livestock Ownership Inspection program.

Based on previous livestock inspection numbers and current livestock inventory, projected livestock inspections are 1.5 million head for FY 27. The calculation for First-Year Impact is based on nine months of inspections at the new fee amount since it will not be in effect for all of FY27.
