Department of Revenue Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held in Room 109 of the Anderson Building; 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, on September 10th, at 10:30 a.m. (Central), to consider the adoption, amendment and repeal of proposed Administrative Rules of South Dakota numbered

§§ 61:24:01:03, 61:24:03:01, 61:24:03:02, 61:24:03:03, 61:24:03:04, 61:24:03:05, 61:24:03:06, 61:24:03:07, 61:24:03:09, 61:24:03:10, 61:24:03:14, 61:24:03:15, 61:24:03:16, 61:24:03:17, 61:24:03:18, 61:24:03:19, 61:24:04:07, 61:24:07:01, 61:24:07:08, and 61:24:07:11

The effect of the rules will be to establish procedures for permanent closure of a motor vehicle dealer, to establish certain required uses of the Department's 605Drive system, to permit retention of electronic records, to require retention of certain paper records for at least a year, to require document fees be advertised for customers in accordance with federal law, to prohibit the use of "broker" and "wholesale" in dealer names and advertising materials, and to provide form and style adjustments.

The reason for adopting the proposed rules is to provide clear expectations in the permanent closure process for motor vehicle dealers, to continue streamlining of processes with required use of the state's 605Drive system, to establish recordkeeping requirements that reflect both the existence of electronic and paper records, and to clean up the existing language for clarity and readability.

Persons interested in presenting amendments, data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may appear in-person at the hearing, or mail or e-mail them to the Department of Revenue at the address or email address listed at the end of this notice. The deadline to submit any such written comments for consideration by the Department of Revenue is September 24, 2026, at 5 p.m. (Central).

After the written comment period, the Department of Revenue will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The Department of Revenue may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.
